Three day 12th Sartyoon Sang Crafts Exhibition was successfully organised by Sindh Rural Support Organization, in collaboration with Sindh Government and other partners. The event's objective was to facilitate better incomes for the #flood-affected women artisans of rural Sindh. Mohtrama Aseefa Bhutto Zardari on first day inaugurated the exhibition at OceanMall, Karachi..

In the exhibition, over 95 Business Development Groups (BDGs) represented 1,572 artisans of 12 districts, showcased and market their hand made crafts including Plazo, Shalwar, Garara, Trouser, Shawl, Duppta, Stoles, Waistcoat, Date Leaf, Wheat Straw, Khussa, Moora, Straw and Rillis, bed sheets and cushions.

Visitors and buyers visited each stall, met with rural artisans and they also got information about their products and #post-flood situation and its impacts on their lives and #livelihood. They appreciated the artisan crafts and exhibition. They arranged such an activity to promote rural artisans and their handicrafts in a big urban market of Karachi. The Chief Executive Officer -SRSO and Manager Crafts and Enterprise Development (CED) facilitated and briefed them during the visit.

The delegation also met with rural community representatives and beneficiaries of SRSO's programs, including Malteser International Cash Grants. The SRSO is also involved in disaster response and recovery efforts in partnership with Malteser International and ADH.

The German delegation appreciated SRSO's work with rural women for empowerment and poverty reduction and gifted German-made Ajrak to women participants. The meeting concluded with the distribution of hygiene kits to promote good health and hygiene.



Free Medical Camps for Flood-affected Communities with Malteser International

Mirpurkhas & Sanghar/February20, 2023

Sindh Rural Support Organization (SRSO) in partnership with Malteser International has extended emergency assistance to monsoon rain flood-affected families in 4 most-affected Union Councils of the districts of Mirpurkhas (Mir Allah Bachyio and Mir Khuda Bux-2 Taluka Jhudho) and Sanghar (UC Jamrao 84 and Jaam Jaani Taluka Jaam Ali Ali Nawaz).

Initially, free medical camps have been started at village level in targeted 4 UCs to provide medical care and treatment. To date, total 10 camps have been organized (7 Mirpurkhas and 3 Sanghar) and treated 2,890 persons (Mirpurkhas 2,042 and) Sanghar 848) by qualified doctors and health team.

During September-December 2022, SRSO with the support of Malteser International has successfully provided immediate emergency assistance included 400 dry ration bags, 200 temporary shelters, 200 hygiene kits, and 400 mosquito nets, 300 cash grants of 32,000 per household, 400 water purification tablets, 300 water canes, and medical care to 16,800 patients of same 4 Union Councils of the both districts.

Livestock fodder were distributed to most-affected and vulnerable 100 households of 04 different villages of union council Mir Allah Bachyio Taluka Jhudho district Mirpurkhas under Malteser International supported emergency assistance project by SRSO. It aims to protect main source of livelihood (livestock) of the calamity-flood victim's families. The distribution was organized at village Haroon and beneficiaries were briefed about the project and support by Project Coordinator.

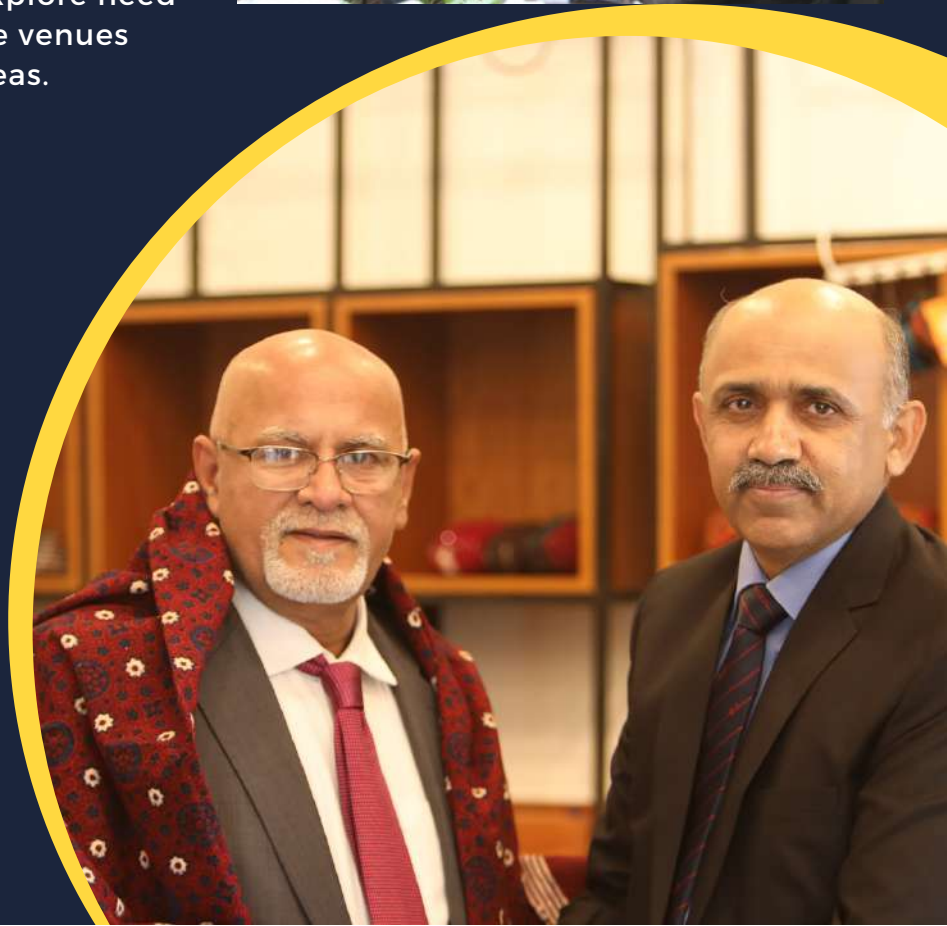

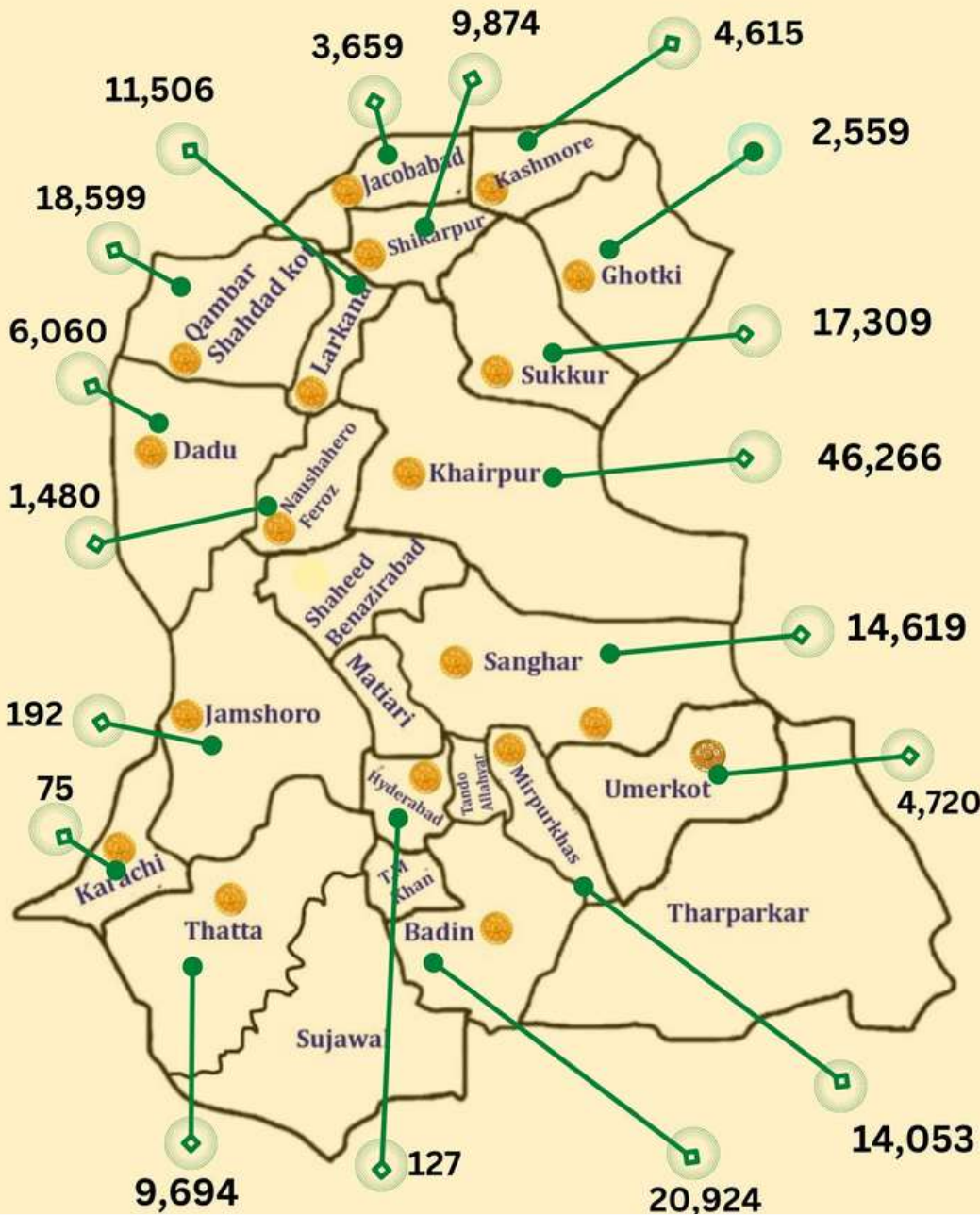

These 2-day trainings were organized in the targeted 5 districts i.e. Khairpur, Naushahro Feroz, Dadu, Larkana and Kamber-Shahdadkot. 148 adolescent champions from targeted 37 union councils were trained on child rights and protection of children, GBV, violence against children, life based skills, psych-social support, nutrition, health & hygiene and mental health in order to protect children from sexual abuse and learned good and bad touch.

They were imparted life based skills through recreational activities such as several games and drawing competition and sessions. After completion of the training, adolescent champions are conducting sessions with children in the villages
