The distribution of Female Dignity Kits is an important step towards meeting the basic needs of women and girls affected by floods. It aimed to ensure that women and girls have access to the basic necessities they need to maintain their health and dignity during times of crisis.

## Sukkur/March13, 2023

The meeting was held with Commissioner Sukkur Division, Mr. Ghulam Mustafa Phull, at his office to discuss the newly initiated Sindh Flood Housing Reconstruction Project, which is being funded by the Government of Sindh in five districts. Mr. Sikander Ali Sanam, SRSO-Project Team Leader, and Mr. Masood Hashami, Company Secretary, who briefed the Commissioner on the key features of the project and its current status, particularly in district Khairpur Mir's. During the briefing, it was explained that the housing project is beneficiary-driven, meaning that the households themselves will be responsible for reconstructing their flood-resilient houses. They will engage local skilled and unskilled labor, with technical assistance provided by SRSO
